Potato Breeder

EarthFresh and Europlant have partnered on the development of a plant breeding initiative that will primarily focus on producing potato varieties suited to regional challenges faced by growers located in Atlantic Canada. Ideally, the person will possess intimate knowledge of potato production in the Atlantic region of Canada, including unique challenges faced by the region's potato industry, and be based in the region. This is not however a prerequisite. More important is the individual's understanding and appreciation of challenges associated with varietal development, selection and multiplication. The ability to purposefully collaborate with the EarthFresh team and Europlant to ensure breeding and multiplication decisions are market driven will be crucial. A postgraduate plant science student with sound industry experience may be considered for the role.

- Management and oversight of sowing, production and harvesting activities
- Perform extensive laboratory analysis and phenotypical evaluation of varietal traits
- Ensure accurate recording then evaluation of all cross-breeding and trial data to annually determine genotype suitability from growing, post-harvest and consumer perspectives
- Budgeting and financial responsibility
- Management of seasonal staff

- Knowledge of the latest potato breeding and cultivar selection techniques (preferred)
- Extensive phytosanitary knowledge and experience, particularly in relation to potato wart (preferred)

- Understanding of Eastern Canada seed and market potato growers' needs and challenges (preferred)
- Practical and proactive hands-on leader mentality (mandatory)
